Content

There are several rounds requiring different skills and strategies for success. Each event takes about two hours, and awards will be given for good teamwork and for the winning team of each round.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can we bring a Year 10 student?

How many teams can we bring?

You can apply to bring up to four teams per school; each pair of teams MUST be accompanied by a responsible adult who will mark for another school. For additional teams, this adult may be a sixth former.

How long does the event last?

Approximately 2 hours.

What kind of refreshments/lunch will be provided?

Refreshments are not provided, it is recommended that pupils bring water.

When will I receive further information?

Approximately 2 weeks beforehand, your organiser will send you details of travel and local arrangements.

Will I be able to bring an extra colleague?

Yes.

One of my students has a disability and will require additional assistance.

Please add this info on the application form and confirm any local arrangements with your organiser when they contact you about 2 weeks beforehand.

How will I know the answers?

We will provide a mark scheme.

Eligibility

Year 9 students only, organised into teams of three. Each pair of teams must be accompanied by a teacher or teaching assistant. Schools entering multiple teams must bring a ratio of one responsible adult per two teams, however for additional teams this could be a sixth former.
