Overview

In this session we will discuss how you - and your school - can meet Gatsby benchmarks 4 and 5 (Linking curriculum learning to careers and Encounters with employers).

Maths4Girls allows educators to invite female (and male) role models who use maths every day in their job, into the classroom. You will also meet some Maths4Girls role models and hear their inspiring career stories for you to take back into the classroom.
